INTERNATIONAL COOPERATION AGREEMENT

Acting under the authority and recommendations of Dean for Curriculum Case Western Reserve University School of Medicine (CWRU SOM), Prof. Amy Wilson-Delfosse, I propose this cooperation agreement between the Faculty of Medicine and Health Sciences of the University of Jan Kochanowski (WLNZ UJK) in Kielce, represented by Prof. Stanisław Głuszek and CWRU SOM in Cleveland, USA, represented by Prof. Tomasz Rogula.

The agreement covers the following areas:

1. Exchange of students between CWRU SOM and WLNZ UJK.
2. Accepting WLNZ UJK students meeting the criteria set by the CWRU SOM <http://casemed.case.edu/registrar/visitingstudents/> for 4-6 week internships (Acting Internship) within the course SURG4006 listed in the directory Clinical Electives. Head of the course is Prof. Tomasz Rogula.

3. The introduction of innovative teaching methods "IQ Case Inquiry" under the direction of Prof. Amy Wilson-Delfosse and Prof. Tomasz Rogula:

- a. Organization of workshops for WLNZ UJK teachers in Kielce.
- b. Participation in courses and trainings for WLNZ UJK teachers in Cleveland.
- c. Participation and mentoring of CWRU SOM teachers and students in classes conducted at WLNZ UJK.
- d. Joint development of cases and reporting results.

4. Scientific and clinical cooperation:

- a. Visiting Research Fellowship for WLNZ UJK students and researchers conducted at CWRU SOM.
- b. Joint scientific research, with reporting results and publications.
- c. Conducting workshops, conferences and scientific trials.
- d. Clinical consultations.

Prof. Tomasz Rogula is the coordinator of these activities on the part of CWRU. The agreement is for an indefinite period and is subject to adjustments mutually agreed conditions. Financing conditions are set out in separate annexes contained within the individual actions of both sides.
