STUDENT AFTER 2ND YEAR OF ENGLISH DIVISION Academic year/.....

After second year of studies, the Students are obligated to compete a **1-week (30 hours)** work placement. Number of **working hours per day - 6.**

Place of work: hospital emergency department

Purpose of practice: Prepare Student to an emergency first response proper for patients state. Get knowledge about organization of rescue operation, treatment and evacuation in disasters, mass infection or mass poisonings and cooperation with other emergency services.

Programme of placement:

- 1. Gaining knowledge about characteristic of doctor work in emergency department.
- **2.** Gaining knowledge about common pediatric and adult patients health problems, surgical, geriatric diseases and problems in emergency departments.
- 3. Getting knowledge about establishing appropriate patient-doctor-patient's family relationships.
- 4. Getting knowledge about creating and leading the emergency team.
- 5. Preparaction to work in the conditions of emergency department.
- **6.** Gaining the ability to establish communication and maintain proper relations and behavior with the patient and medical staff.
- **7.** Takes history from the child and his family; carries out a full and targeted physical examination of an adult patient.
- 8. Evaluates the general condition of the patient, consciousness and awareness level.
- 9. Evaluates and describing the somatic and psychiatric patient's state.
- 10. Recognize life-threatening conditions.
- 11. Recognize alcohol, narcotics and other drug abuse.
- 12. Student is planning a diagnostic, therapeutic and preventive procedures.
- 13. Qualifies the patient for home and hospital treatment.



- 14. Interprets laboratory test results and identifies cause of abnormalities.
- **15.** Plans a procedures in case of possible blood-transmitted infection.
- 16. Mastering the skills of performing main doctor's procedures:
 - a) measurements of body temperature, pulse rate, blood pressure and respiration rate

 \mathbf{b}) intravenous injection , intramuscular and subcutaneous injections, cannulation of peripheral

veins, collection of peripheral venous blood, collection of arterial blood, collection arterialized capillary blood,

- c) collecting swabs from the nose, throat and skin, puncture of pleural cavity
- d) getting and interpretation of the ECG
- e) simple test strips and measuring the concentration of glucose in the blood
- f) takes samples for laboratory diagnostic tests
