Collegium Medicum, UJK Kielce
FOR PRACTICAL TRAINING
IN MEDICAL FACILITIES
(for practical classes / exercises and internship)

Information for the student

Before entering the practical classes, the student is obliged to show himself to the teacher conducting the classes, and before starting the internship - to the directional tutor and tutor in the department:

1. The original of a valid health booklet for sanitary and epidemiological purposes, containing entries:

- The results of a faecal carrier test
- A valid medical certificate for sanitary and epidemiological purposes confirming that there are no health contraindications for undertaking education, in which there is a possibility of transmitting the infection to other people (such a certificate is issued by a doctor authorized to perform preventive examinations - some GPs and occupational medicine doctors). This ruling must be updated when the next examination is scheduled.

Warning!

All first-year students have the opportunity to perform carrier tests free of charge on the basis of a letter sent by the University to the Sanitary and Epidemiological Station in Kielce, at Jagiellońska Street.

2. Document confirming vaccination with the hepatitis B vaccine

3. Important insurance policies:

- Civil liability (OC) in connection with the performance of medical services (during practical vocational training)
- Consequences of Personal Accidents (NNW) with a clause covering the costs of treatment after exposure (HIV exposure / infection, hepatitis)

Warning!

Having a third party liability and accident insurance policy protects the Student against incurring financial responsibility in the event of unfortunate events or harm caused by the Student during practical apprenticeship.

4. In the case of the Provincial Integrated Hospital in Kielce - a Circulation Card with entries documenting the completion of health and safety training, fire prevention and hospital infections.
